### 1. Registration, Per Person Deposit, Mission Trip Fees.

- [Per Person Deposit Form](#) - Needed for paying your Per Person deposit fee

Note: Please remember that out of your final mission trip fee payment, we'll need you to bring with you to Mexico, \$100 per person for teams of 20 or more, and \$150 per person for teams of 19 or less in U.S. Dollars (cash). This is used for purchasing your building materials and etc. Please let us know if this puts a hardship on you. We'll gladly make other arrangements for you. ## **Mission Trip Fee Pricing**

### **Fees for teams of 20 or more (not including Pre-School)**

- Adults/Teens (ages 13 & Older) \$225 per person
- Children (ages 6 - 12) \$200 per person
- Pre-school (ages 0-5) Free

### **Fees for teams of 15-19 (not including Pre-School)**

- Adults/Teens (ages 13 & Older) \$275 per person
- Children (ages 6 - 12) \$250 per person
- Pre-School (ages 0-5) Free

### **Fees for teams of 10-14 (not including Pre-School)**

- Adults/Teens (ages 13 & Older) \$375 per person
- Children (ages 6 - 12) \$350 per person
- Pre-School (ages 0-5) Free

### **Fees for teams of 5-9 (not including Pre-School)**

- Adults/Teens (ages 13 & Older) \$500 per person
- Children (ages 6 - 12) \$450 per person
- Pre-School (ages 0-5) Free

## 2. Items to carry with you for travel in Mexico

- **Passports or Original Birth Certificate and Photo I.D. Required by all.** (Original Birth Certificate and Photo I.D. are accepted at this time for re-entry into the U.S.A.) In addition, children not accompanied by their parents must have Form A (Notarized permission for minors to travel in Mexico).
- **Tourist Cards**? See crossing the border on the website regarding tourist cards.

## 3. Ministry Items Needed For Your Ministries

- V.B.S. Crafts and snacks (5 V.B.S.'s @ 100 per V.B.S. packaged in bags of ten each)
- Two cases of NIV Bibles **in Spanish** (That have both O.T and N.T.) - Order from: International Bible Society, Tel: 1-800-524-1588 or go to their website at: [www.ibsdirect.com](http://www.ibsdirect.com)
- 1000 tracks - These can be ordered from: Chick Publications, Tel: 909-941-8128, [www.chick.com](http://www.chick.com), one of the more popular tracts is, "Esta fue tu vida, This was your life". Another website you can order from that is real good is: [www.atstracts.org](http://www.atstracts.org) (Go to "**Category**" on the left side of their page, then select "**Spanish**"). It is best to order a variety of different tracks. Here are a few we recommend: "Y ... Entonces Que" (And now what), "Iré al Cielo" (Will I Go to Heaven?), "4 Verdades que Dios Quiere que Sepas" (4 Truths God Wants you to Know) **Make sure you order tracts in Spanish and with a cartoon format.**
- Some game equipment for your game time for your VBS's
- A total of 16 testimonies (4 geared for adults, 12 geared for children)
- About 50-75 prizes for children who can say their memory verses for the VBS time. More on VBS prizes on website.

## 4. Meal Prep

- Meals while at ministry base
- Meals at church you'll be serving at (\$3.50 per meal per person). This is highly recommended.

## 5. Prep For Your Stay At The Ministry Base

- Sleeping bag & pillow (all bunk beds have cushions)
- Paper products: plates, bowls, cups, paper towels, napkins and etc. (see shopping list on website)
- First Aid kit - We have some at the mission base, but you might want one for traveling and keeping with you.
- Other items (see shopping list on website)
- Staying in touch with your loved ones back home Bring your cell phone pre-programmed for use in Mexico. We also have some loaner cell phones that use prepaid cards if you'd like to use them. And lastly, we have wireless internet if you'd like to bring your laptop for staying in touch (recommended only for leaders).
