Work Projects

In the mornings, from about 9:00 -12:00, your group will do various projects at the church where your group will be serving during the week. These projects include: cement work, block work, construction, painting, cleaning, and a host of whatever kind of jobs the church might have need of. We take into account the skills of your group and the needs of the church in choosing your work projects.

For those in your group, who might not be able to participate in the work time for whatever reasons, are not obligated to work. We also offer a visitation/prayer ministry in the mornings if some would prefer to do ministry. We leave it up to you and your group to choose what you'd prefer to do. For those unable to work, or want to do some lighter, easier job, there is always something for everyone. Don't feel pressured on our part regarding work projects. We'll work with you in any way possible so that it's a positive experience for everyone.

Materials for your work projects are paid for from your group fees, so there's no need to worry about additional funds for work projects.

There is not a lot you have to prepare for regarding your work projects. We'll provide most of the tools you'll need (unless it's a large project or you'd rather use you own tools) and will arrange and organize everything prior to your arrival. We'll even have all the materials you'll need on site and ready to go. In short, we'll handle all the details for you.
